**HUD invests in Ohio People and communities.** About \$2.1 Billion in tax dollars is invested in Ohio annually through HUD programs. In addition, HUD programs currently leverage over \$46 Billion in private sector investment in housing in Ohio. About 1 in 5 families has a place to call home from a HUD program.

**HUD provides funding** to the State of Ohio, larger cities and urban counties, Public Housing Authorities, HUD Multifamily Developments and many grantees throughout Ohio in both urban and rural areas.
